On behalf of the National Association of Flood and Stormwater Management Agencies (NAFSMA), I want to invite you to participate in an important one-day Flood Risk Resiliency Roundtable. The meeting will begin to foster a dialogue and solicit input from public works agencies, flood control districts, as well as wastewater and water utility districts that are responsible for maintaining critical water infrastructure during and following natural disasters that can help guide local, regional and national resiliency efforts.

The meeting will be held at the Menger Hotel in downtown San Antonio (located along the Riverwalk) on Thursday, May 31, 2018.
